Step 1:

Print out the activity files below (pages 3-6)

Step 2:

Use the example books to practice folding (paper and video instructions provided.)

Step 3:

Draw your own comic in the blank template!

Step 4:

Scan your completed comic onto a computer or make copies on a copier.


Step 5:

Once you have copies of your page, fold them all up.


Step 6:

Print out the blank mini book template and 2 example books. One example book shows kids HOW to make a book. The other is a silly shark story for kicks and giggles.




You can print out the folding instructions or use them from your device. There is also a QR code linked to a video with step-by-step folding instructions.
